WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small files that are stored on the hard drive of Users of the Site. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Site or third parties to recognize you as a User and make it easier for you to use the Site while subsequent visits. These cookies allow the Company to track the use of the Site and its functions. Using them allows us to better and more effectively serve Users and personalize the Site for a specific User.

HOW DOES THE COMPANY USE COOKIES?

When you visit the Site, various cookies may be stored on your disk.

The Company may use cookies to recognize repeated User visits, the type of content viewed and other sites to which the User was redirected from the Site, the time when each page and section of the Site was opened, and the functions used. All Personal Data that may be contained in cookies are processed based on the consent of the relevant subject in accordance with the Privacy Policy.

We use both persistent and session cookies, as well as their varieties for the operation of the Site:

Essential cookies: necessary for the normal functioning of the Site. The Company may use essential cookies to authenticate users, prevent fraudulent use of accounts, or provide certain features of the Site.

Analytics and performance cookies: to provide our products to Users and improve the quality of interaction, we use cookies and other identifiers to collect data about Site usage and performance.

Functional cookies: this type of cookies is used to recognise repeat visits to the Site. Allow the contents of the Site to be personalised for Users and save selected settings (e.g.language).

SETTING UP THE USE OF COOKIES

To find out how to delete cookies and how to configure deletion or refuse them, use the help function in your web browser. Most browsers are pre-set to accept cookies automatically. You can object to the creation of cookies by disabling cookies in your browser's system settings. Please note, however, that some of the cookies are technically necessary for the functionality of our website, otherwise the page cannot be requested and displayed. By disabling cookies, you will not be able to use parts of the website (without restrictions). We will only use cookies that are not technically necessary for the functionality of our Site if you have provided us with your prior express consent. In addition, you can also control the installation of cookies yourself at any time by changing your browser settings and/or deleting all cookies.

THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

We may employ third-party companies and individuals on our websites – for example, analytics providers and content partners. We grant these third parties access to selected information to perform specific tasks on our behalf. They may also set third-party cookies in order to deliver the services they are providing. Third-party cookies can be used to track you on other websites that use the same third-party service. As we have no control over third-party cookies, they are not covered by this cookie policy.

CONTROL OR OPT OUT OF COOKIES

If you do not wish to accept cookies from us, you can instruct your browser to refuse cookies from our website. Most browsers are configured to accept cookies by default, but you can update these settings to either refuse cookies altogether, or to notify you when a website is trying to set or update a cookie.

If you browse websites from multiple devices, you may need to update your settings on each individual device.

Although some cookies can be blocked with little impact on your experience of a website, blocking all cookies may mean you are unable to access certain features and content across the websites you visit.

POLICY CHANGE

This Policy may be revised, changed, updated and / or amended at any time without prior notice at the Company's discretion.
